The Change of Angle will consist of a far more *practical* approach.



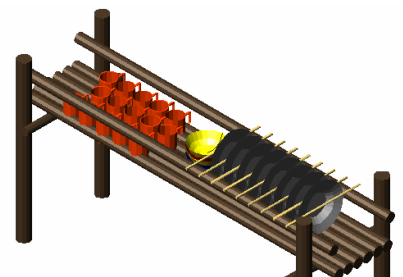

- Central Cleaning. Troop Ware and Cutlery to be brought into a nightly inter-patrol Meal Competition
- One Troop Site. A *practical* copy of our troop competition site with all useful gadgets being used. The Change here is that each patrol will be given one gadget to design and construct.

Survivor Base Challenges

Survivor Base Challenges were invented at our camp in 2002 and have been a major part of our inter-patrol / camp evening programme each year since. There will be many great new Survivor Base Challenges again this year.

5 points for winners, 3 for second, 2 points for 3rd place and 1 point for 4th place.

Central (troop) Gadget Building.

On Friday night the 10th of July each patrol will be drawn a Gadget they will have to construct. E.G. the Fox may get the Dresser.

They will be in charge of designing and construction this.

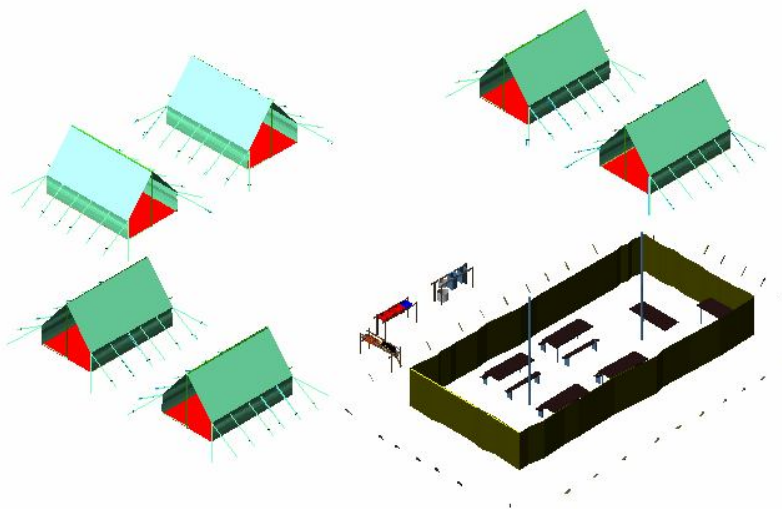
Note: in the second week of camp each patrol will have to switch in the maintenance of these Gadgets.

Duty Patrol

As always Duty Patrol is a very important job on Camp. As a patrol you are only on duty once every 4 days so it is expected that you and the rest of your patrol work hard. Each patrol will be marked on a daily basis while on duty.

Your tasks as a Duty patrol are as follows.

- Raise and Lower Flag.
- Set up and cook all meals.
- Clean up is a major part of this camp. (The Cleanest patrol on this camp will probably win the inter-patrol.)
- Look after Cooler packs
- Be responsible for Bread and milk supplies daily
