Duty Patrol Hand over --- What is this

- At 10am each morning a fall in of the Duty patrol and a leader will take place. The troop pots will then be taken from the old Duty Patrols site...
- The new Patrol will now take over the troops services.

Campcraft - Interpatrol

Here is a list of the Gadgets you will require..

- Dresser (to suit holding all troop pots and Patrol equipment)
- Wash rack (to suit troop wash up)
- Bin Area (To suit Troop)
- Personal Hygiene area, (this will be used after activates)
- Gateway
- Boundaries
- Bench area (To be used for Survivor bases)

Tent inspections

- Tents will get an inspection most days. All aspects will be inspected. It will make plenty sense to put tent up correctly from Day one..

- Hygiene and layout will be inspected most days. Yes, your tent needs to be clean at all times. (keep organised and this is easy)
