Scout camp this year took place in Stanzach, Austria. Stanzach is a small village in the Austian Alps on the boarder of Germany. The camp was very well attended with 40 scouts and leaders. This years camp was a little different to previous years as we stayed in a hostel.

Travel

We booked Ryanair flights from Kerry to Frankfurt over Christmas. This enabled us to keep the cost of the camp down. At Frankfurt we meet up with our bus. We had the use of this bus for the two weeks. In total we covered over a 1000 km's so we got great use out of the coach.

Hostel

Our hostel was excellent with plenty of room and had some very practical facilities for our large group. The Kitchen and the dining rooms had every thing we needed.

Stanzach

The hostel was positioned in the Small town of Stanzch. Jeka have a number of hostels in the which added to the enjoyment for our scouts. There was a football pitch and volleyball court in the town which we made use of.

Camp this year took place on Saturday the 21st of July to Friday 3rd of August. This year's trip was very well attended with 26 scouts and 14 leaders / helpers.

Stanzach, Austria

The stunning scenery of Stanzach will simply take your breath away. Located in the Province of Tyrol in the north west corner of Austria, it is a deeply glaciated valley, hemmed by the mountain ranges of the Lechtaler and Allgauer Alps. Our centres are situated in the different villages along the valley all with their own individual charm. In several of the villages are heated outdoor pools, always a popular place on a sunny afternoon. Above the village of Bach is a chairlift where at the top there are spectacular views of the whole region. From the main valley small side roads lead to the higher mountain hamlets, which make an ideal starting point for an endless choice of mountain hikes. In the mountains there are several beautifully appointed mountain lodges, where groups away on two day excursions can overnight. With a huge range

of activities available including mountain biking, white water rafting, canyoning, roller-blading, dry tobogganing and many more, this is a destination with something to suit everyone

Stanzach is the centre of all Jeka Holiday operations in Austria as they have an office there. I think this is only about 3 or 4 houses away which will be useful if we need it.

Our Hostel

Looks excellent with room to hold about 45 people. Two floors and very similar to the hostel in this picture. The hostel will be for our own use only and have a Kitchen area, showers and bedrooms that hold 6 to 8 People.

We will have a total of 24 scouts and 11 leaders Attend this scout camp.
